THE COOK ISLANDS APPLIED REGULATIONS ORDER 1947, AMENDMENT NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 21st day of October 1953

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Cook Islands Act 1915, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. This order may be cited as the Cook Islands Applied Regulations Order 1947, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Cook Islands Applied Regulations Order 1947* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
- 2. The principal order is hereby amended by adding the following clause:
- "5. The Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939 shall, in their application to the Cook Islands, have effect as if they had been amended by adding to subclause (1) of regulation 13 the following paragraph:
 - ""(e) To exempt from time to time, by notice given in such manner as it thinks fit, any goods, or goods belonging to a specified kind or class, from the operation of these regulations"."
- 3. The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking so much thereof as relates to the Price Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1939 and Amendment No. 1 of those regulations.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.]

This order provides that the Price Tribunal of the Cook Islands shall have power to exempt goods of specified kinds or classes from the operation of the Control of Prices Emergency Regulations 1939, which, though revoked in New Zealand, are still in force in the Cook Islands. It also provides that the Price Stabilization Emergency Regulations 1939 are to cease to be in force in the Cook Islands.
