COOK ISLANDS CUSTOMS DUTIES ORDER 1948

Present :

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by section 302 of the Customs Act, 1913, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Cook Islands Customs Duties Order 1948.

2. This Order shall come into force on the day of enactment hereof, subject always to the provisions of section 652 of the Cook Islands Act, 1915.

3. The Order in Council made on the 29th day of October, 1934, under section 8 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1934, and section 302 of the Customs Act, 1913, is hereby amended by revoking the proviso thereto.

4. The Cook Islands Customs Duties Order 1942 is hereby amended :

(a) By revoking the words " Subject to clause 3 of this Order " in clause 2 thereof; and

(b) By revoking clause 3 thereof.

5. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the said Order in Council made on the 29th day of October, 1934, as hereby amended, or in the Cook Islands Customs Duties Order, 1942, as hereby amended, it is hereby ordered that, in lieu of the duty provided for in the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1934, and Part I of the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1942, there shall be payable a duty of 2s. per pound on all black twist tobacco imported into or entered for home consumption in the Cook Islands (including the Island of Niue) the genuine invoice value of which at the time of importation is proved to the satisfaction of the Collector of Customs not to exceed 8s. per pound, and the Tariff is hereby modified accordingly.
