## THE COOK ISLANDS COUNCILS REGULATIONS 1946, AMENDMENT NO. 4

## Present:

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Cook Islands Act 1915, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Cook Islands Councils Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Cook Islands Councils Regulations 1946\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. (1) The principal regulations, as amended by the Cook Islands Councils Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 2, are hereby further amended by revoking regulation 34, and substituting the following heading and regulation:

#### "PART VI—PAYMENT OF MEMBERS

"34. (1) There shall be paid, from the Cook Islands Account and the Niue Island Account respectively, to every person, other than a Resident Commissioner or Resident Agent, holding office as a member of an Island Council established by these regulations or of the Island Council of Niue, an allowance at such rate or rates as may be determined from time to time by the Minister of Island Territories with the concurrence of the Minister of Finance, payable monthly on the last day of each month of the year, subject to apportionment for any part of a month included in his term of office.

"(2) Different rates may be so determined in respect of different islands and in respect of different electoral districts in any island."

(2) The Cook Islands Councils Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 2, are hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general

The effect of this amendment is that payments to members of Island Councils of the Cook Islands may be fixed at different rates for the several islands and for the several electoral districts in any island, and that payments may be made monthly instead of quarterly.
