THE CHATHAM ISLANDS DUES REGULATIONS 1951,
AMENDMENT NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 18th day of May 1955

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Chatham Islands County Council Empowering Act 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Chatham Islands Dues Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Chatham Islands Dues Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the item "Cattle not otherwise provided for, per head" in paragraph (1) the expression "0 11 0", and substituting the expression "1 0 0".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations increase the dues payable on cattle (other than bulls) imported into or exported from that part of the Chatham Islands County comprising Chatham Island from 11s. per head to £1 per head.
