**THE CHATHAM ISLANDS DUES REGULATIONS 1951,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 2nd day of October 1957

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Chatham Islands County Council Empowering Act 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Chatham Islands Dues Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Chatham Islands Dues Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November 1957.

2. The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (2), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(2) In respect of the following goods imported into or exported from that portion of the county comprising the islands other than Chatham Island:

These regulations substitute a new scale of dues on goods imported into or exported from that part of the County of Chatham Islands comprising the islands other than Chatham Island.
