ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 21st day of January 1969

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. J. R. MARSHALL, PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Chatham Islands County Council Empowering Act 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Chatham Islands Dues Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Chatham Islands Dues Regulations 1951\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Scale of dues**—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Schedule thereto (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Chatham Islands Dues Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 6), and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The Chatham Islands Dues Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 6, are hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations substitute a new scale of dues on goods imported into or exported from the County of Chatham Islands. The only changes are—

- (a) Dues at the rate of 4 cents per pound are prescribed in respect of crayfish:
- (b) Dues at the rate of \$8 per ton are prescribed in respect of diesel fuel oil imported into Chatham Island, and at the rate of \$4 per ton in respect of diesel fuel oil imported into any other islands other than Chatham Island.
