ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 8th day of September 1969

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Chatham Islands County Council Empowering Act 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Chatham Islands Dues Regulations 1951, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Chatham Islands Dues Regulations 1951* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 15th day of September 1969.
- 2. Dues on crayfish—(1) The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from clause (1) the item relating to crayfish, and substituting the following item:
 - "Crayfish, per pound 0.02".
- (2) The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from clause (2) the item relating to crayfish, and substituting the following item:

"Crayfish, per pound 0.02".

These regulations reduce from 4 cents per pound to 2 cents per pound the levy on crayfish imported into or exported from the Chatham Islands.
