**THE COOK ISLANDS FRUIT REGULATIONS 1928,  
AMENDMENT NO. 8**

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Cook Islands Act 1915, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Cook Islands Fruit Regulations 1928, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Cook Islands Fruit Regulations 1928\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations, as amended by the Cook Islands Fruit Regulations 1928, Amendment No. 3, is hereby amended by adding to subclause (1) the following proviso:

“ Provided that the Minister may at any time and for such period as he thinks fit permit the export of oranges of a greater or lesser diameter than is specified in this regulation.”
