THE CONSUMER INFORMATION (QUANTITY) NOTICE 1973

PURSUANT to the Consumer Information Act 1969, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Consumer Information (Quantity) Notice 1973.

(2) This notice shall come into force 6 months after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Packaged goods to bear label showing quantity—Every packager of the goods specified in the Schedule hereto shall cause packages containing the goods to bear a label showing the quantity of the goods in the package expressed in the manner specified in the said Schedule.

SCHEDULE

By Weight or Fluid Measure, as the case may require

Cosmetics and toiletries, other than—

- (a) Packages containing less than 1 ounce, 1 fluid ounce, or metric equivalents:
- (b) Packages containing 2 or more items if the individual items comply with this notice.

Deodorants.

Air fresheners.

Bleaches.

Dyes.

Starches.

Blues.

Polishes of all kinds.

Window-cleaning fluids.

Insect repellants and destructors.

Drinking straws.

Paper cups.

Paper plates.
