

THE CHEESE INDUSTRY (REGISTRATION OF EMPLOYMENT) ORDER 1941.

Pursuant to Regulation 9B of the National Service Emergency Regulations 1940, the Minister of National Service doth hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Cheese Industry (Registration of Employment) Order 1941.

2. In this Order, unless inconsistent with the context,—

"Cheese-factory" means a manufacturing dairy registered under the Dairy-produce Regulations 1938* in which labour is

employed in the manufacture of cheese:

"Owner", in relation to any cheese-factory, means the owner thereof, whether jointly or severally, and includes the owner's agent or manager; it includes also, in the case of a company, the manager, secretary, or other principal officer thereof.

- 3. The owner of every cheese-factory existing on the date of this Order and the owner of every manufacturing dairy that becomes a cheese-factory between the date of this Order and the end of the 1941–42 season shall register himself in accordance with this Order and shall furnish at the time of registration the following information and particulars in respect of the cheese-factory:—
 - (a) The number of men actually engaged therein in the manufacture of cheese at the time of registration:
 - (b) The estimated number of men required in respect of the manufacture of cheese for the 1941–42 season:
 - (c) The number of men for whose employment in the manufacture of cheese as from the commencement of the 1941–42 season arrangements have been made:
 - (d) The additional living accommodation over and above that available at the date of this Order which it is estimated will be required for employees during the 1941–42 season:
 - (e) The total output of cheese during the 1940–41 season, and the estimated total output for the 1941–42 season:
 - (f) The number of vats utilized in the production of cheese during the 1940-41 season, and the number of vats intended to be utilized therefor during the 1941-42 season:
 - (g) Such further and other information and particulars as may be required in the form of application for registration.
- 4. Registration under clause 3 hereof shall be effected by completing a form of application for registration provided by the Minister for the purpose, and by forwarding the completed form to the Director of

National Service at Wellington within fourteen days after the date of this Order or within fourteen days after the date when the manufacturing dairy becomes a cheese-factory, whichever is the later.

5. Every person who at the date of this Order is engaged as a

5. Every person who at the date of this Order is engaged as a worker in any cheese-factory in the manufacture of cheese, and every other person who at any time within the five years immediately preceding the date of this Order has for a continuous period of not less than three months been engaged as a worker in any cheese-factory in the manufacture of cheese but who is at present not so engaged, shall register in accordance with this Order, and shall furnish such information and particulars concerning himself as are required by the form of application for registration:

Provided that the provisions of this clause shall not apply to any member of the armed Forces other than the Territorial Force.

6. Registration under clause 5 hereof shall be effected by completing a form of application for registration provided by the Minister for the purpose, and by forwarding the completed form to the Director of National Service at Wellington within fourteen days after the date of this Order.

7. The owner of every cheese-factory shall, within the first three days of each calendar month, furnish to the nearest Placement Officer a return giving the following information and particulars:—

(a) The name and address of each worker who has commenced employment in the factory during the preceding calendar month, together with the actual date of the commencement of employment, the capacity in which he has been engaged, and, if available, particulars of his previous employment:

(b) The name of each worker whose engagement in the cheese-factory has terminated during the preceding calendar month, and, if available, particulars of his new employment and of his new address:

(c) The vacancies and types of vacancies existing at the date of the return for which workers are required.

8. Every worker whose name has been furnished to a Placement Officer in pursuance of clause 7 (a) hereof shall, if not previously registered hereunder, be deemed to have been registered in accordance with this Order.

9. The owner of every cheese-factory shall, within forty-eight hours after notification of an intention to terminate any contract of employment, whether given by the employer to the worker or by the worker to the employer, advise the nearest Placement Officer thereof, giving the reason for the termination of employment and, if possible, the proposed new address and employment of the worker.

10. An acknowledgment of registration under this Order shall be given to the person registered by the Director of National Service, or if registration is pursuant to clause 7 hereof, then by the Placement

Officer on behalf of the Director.
