**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 48 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Import Prohibition (Iraq and Kuwait) Order 1990.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Importation from Iraq or Kuwait**—The importation of any goods that are the produce or manufacture of, or are exported from, Iraq or Kuwait is hereby prohibited, except with the consent of the Minister of Customs and subject to such conditions as the Minister thinks fit to impose.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order prohibits the importation of any goods that are the produce or manufacture of, or are exported from, Iraq or Kuwait, except with the consent of the Minister of Customs and subject to such conditions as the Minister thinks fit to impose.
