### Order

#### 1 Title

- (1) This order is the Customs Import Prohibition (Trout) Amendment Order 2004.
- (2) In this order, the Customs Import Prohibition (Trout) Order 2001<sup>1</sup> is called “the principal order”.

#### 2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 7 November 2004.

**3 Expiry**

Clause 3 of the principal order is amended by omitting the words “7 November 2004”, and substituting the words “7 November 2007”.
