



**THE CUSTOMS IMPORT PROHIBITION (BRAZILIAN FILA
DOGS) ORDER 1991**

PURSUANT to section 48 of the Customs Act 1966, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Customs Import Prohibition (Brazilian Fila Dogs) Order 1991.

2. Commencement and expiry—(1) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

(2) This order shall continue in force until the close of the 8th day of May 1991, and shall then expire.

3. Importation of goods prohibited—The importation of dogs of the *Fila Brasileiro* (Brazilian Fila) breed is hereby prohibited.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order prohibits the importation of Brazilian Fila dogs for a period of approximately 2 months. The order comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, and expires with the close of the 8th day of May 1991.
