



**THE CUSTOMS IMPORT PROHIBITION (AQUATIC FAUNA)
ORDER 1989**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 22nd day of May 1989

Present:

THE HON. M. K. MOORE PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 48 of the Customs Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Customs Import Prohibition (Aquatic Fauna) Order 1989.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Importation of goods prohibited—The importation of the goods specified in the First Schedule to this Order is hereby prohibited, except with the consent of the Minister of Agriculture and subject to such conditions as the Minister thinks fit to impose.

3. The importation of the goods specified in the Second Schedule to this Order is hereby prohibited.

4. The Customs Import Prohibition (Aquatic Fauna) Order 1988* and the Customs Import Prohibition (Aquatic Fauna) Order 1988, Amendment No. 1† are hereby revoked.

SCHEDULES

FIRST SCHEDULE

CONDITIONALLY PROHIBITED IMPORTS

Live Channel Catfish (*Ictalurus punctatus*) at any stage of its life cycle.

SECOND SCHEDULE

ABSOLUTELY PROHIBITED IMPORTS

Live—

- (a) Red Abalone (*Haliotis rufescens*);
 - (b) Chinese King Prawns (*Peneaus orientalis* spp);
 - (c) Red Claw Crayfish (*Cherax quadracarinatus*),—
- at any stage of their life cycle.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, allows for the Minister of Agriculture to give consent to the importation of Channel Catfish, but maintains the import prohibition on the other species of aquatic fauna previously included in the Customs Import Prohibition (Aquatic Fauna) Order 1988 and the Customs Import Prohibition (Aquatic Fauna) Order 1988, Amendment No. 1.
