HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

By virtue of the Cook Islands Act, 1915, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Cook Islands Pearl-shell Fisheries Regulations Amendment 1938.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Cook Islands Pearl-shell Fisheries Regulations 1921*, the Cook Islands Pearl-shell Fisheries Regulations Amendment 1928[†], and the Cook Islands Pearl-shell Fisheries Regulations Amendment 1936.1

3. These regulations shall come into force on the date of the notification hereof in the New Zealand Gazette.

4. Regulations numbered respectively 5 and 6 of the Cook Islands Pearl-shell Fisheries Regulations Amendment 1936 are hereby amended by omitting the words" from the date of coming into force of this Order in Council until the 31st day of December, 1937", where they occur in the said regulations, and by substituting therefor the words " until the 31st day of December, 1940".
