**THE CUSTOMS IMPORT PROHIBITION (FRESH GRAPES)
ORDER 1960**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 30th day of November 1960

Present:
HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 46 of the Customs Act 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being of the opinion that the prohibition hereinafter enacted is necessary in the public interest, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Import Prohibition (Fresh Grapes) Order 1960.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. The importation of fresh grapes is prohibited, except with the consent of the Minister of Customs.
