THE CUSTOMS IMPORT PROHIBITION ORDER 1946

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 16th day of January, 1946

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 46 of the Customs Act, 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and being of opinion that the prohibition hereinafter enacted is necessary in the public interest, doth hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Import Prohibition Order 1946.

2. This Order shall come into force on the day following notification of the making thereof in the *Gazette*.

3. The importation is prohibited, save with the consent of the Minister of Customs, of "Lockaid" lock-picking "guns" manufactured by the Majestic Lock Company of New York, and similar lock-picking devices.
