**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 7th day of  
November 1951

Present :

**HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to section 46 of the Customs Act 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being of opinion that the prohibition hereinafter enacted is necessary in the public interest, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1.** (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Import Prohibition Order 1951.

(2) This Order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2.** The importation is prohibited, save with the consent of the Minister of Customs, of fresh pineapples.
