**THE CUSTOMS IMPORT PROHIBITION (RHODESIA) ORDER
1965**

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 46 of the Customs Act 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being of opinion that the prohibition hereinafter enacted is necessary in the public interest, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Import Prohibition (Rhodesia) Order 1965.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 25th day of November 1965.

2. The importation of goods of the class specified in the Schedule hereto is hereby prohibited, except any such goods in respect of which the Minister of Customs is satisfied that—

- (a) On or before the 23rd day of November 1965 they had been purchased by or on behalf of an importer in New Zealand for the purpose of their importation into New Zealand; and
- (b) On or before the 31st day of December 1965 they were on board a ship, or at a port outside Rhodesia awaiting shipment, for importation into New Zealand.

SCHEDULE

PROHIBITED IMPORT

Tobacco, being the produce or manufacture of Rhodesia.
