

THE CUSTOMS IMPORT PROHIBITION (POLIOMYELITIS VACCINE) ORDER 1957

PURSUANT to section 46 of the Customs Act 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being of the opinion that the prohibition hereinafter enacted is necessary in the public interest, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Import Prohibition (Poliomyelitis Vaccine) Order 1957.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day following the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. The importation is prohibited of poliomyelitis vaccine except pursuant to a permit issued by the Director of the Division of Public Hygiene of the Department of Health.
