PURSUANT to section 46 of the Customs Act 1913, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being of opinion that the prohibition hereinafter enacted is necessary in the public interest, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Import Prohibition (North Vietnam) Order 1966.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.

2. The importation of any goods that are the produce or manufacture of, or are exported from, North Vietnam is hereby prohibited.
