THE COOK ISLANDS SEA CARRIAGE OF GOODS ORDER 1946

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 20th day of November, 1946

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. W. NASH PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to section 14 of the Sea Carriage of Goods Act, 1940, and section 53 of the Cook Islands Act, 1915, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Cook Islands Sea Carriage of Goods Order 1946.
- 2. This Order shall come into force on the 1st day of December, 1946 (by the New Zealand calendar).
- 3. The provisions of Part I and Part II of the Sea Carriage of Goods Act, 1940, shall, subject to the adaptations hereinafter contained, apply to the Cook Islands in the same manner in all respects as if the Cook Islands were for all purposes part of New Zealand, and the term "New Zealand" as used in that Act shall, both in New Zealand and in the Cook Islands, be construed as including the Cook Islands accordingly.
- 4. (1) The provisions of sections 11 and 12 and subsection (2) of section 13 of the said Act shall extend to and be in force in the Cook Islands.
- (2) Every reference in the said section 11 to New Zealand shall be read as a reference to the Cook Islands.
