ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 149 of the Criminal Justice Act 1985, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Criminal Justice Regulations 1985, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Criminal Justice Regulations 1985* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1987.
- 2. Determination of offenders' remission dates—Regulation 8 (3) of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.
 - 3. Transitional provision—(1) This regulation applies in respect of—(a) Every sentence of imprisonment imposed on or after the 1st day of October 1985, but before the 1st day of August 1987; and

(b) Every sentence of imprisonment, and every sentence of preventive detention, imposed in substitution for any sentence referred to in paragraph (a) of this subclause.

(2) In determining any inmate's remission date under regulation 8 (2) of the principal regulations in respect of any sentence to which this regulation applies, the Secretary shall take into account the total period (if any) during which the inmate was held on remand in penal custody at any stage of the proceedings leading to the inmate's conviction or pending sentence, being the period specified by the Court on the warrant of commitment in accordance with section 81 (2) of the Act (as originally enacted).

The amendments are consequential upon the enactment of section 8 of the Criminal Justice Amendment Act (No. 3) 1987.
