## THE CIVIL LIST (ANNUITIES) DETERMINATION 1990

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Civil List Act 1979 (as amended by section 4 of the Civil List Amendment Act 1985) and to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, the Higher Salaries Commission hereby makes the following determination.

## DETERMINATION

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Civil List (Annuities) Determination 1990.
- (2) This determination shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1990.
- 2. Annuity for former Governor-General—The annuity payable under section 4 (1) of the Civil List Act 1979 to a person who has held office as Governor-General and who was, at the time of that person's appointment, domiciled in New Zealand shall be paid,—
  - (a) If that person held office as Governor-General for a total period of less than 2 complete years, at the yearly rate of \$7,280:
  - (b) If that person held office as Governor-General for a total period of 2 complete years or more, at the yearly rate of \$7,280 for each complete year (not exceeding 5) of that total period.
- **3.** Annuity for widow or widower of former Governor-General—The annuity payable under section 4 (2) of the Civil List Act 1979 to the widow or widower of a person who held office as Governor-General and who was, at the time of that person's appointment, domiciled in New Zealand shall be paid,—
  - (a) If that person held office as Governor-General for a total period of less than 2 complete years, at the yearly rate of \$3,640:
  - (b) If that person held office as Governor-General for a total period of 2 complete years or more, at the yearly rate of \$3,640 for each complete year (not exceeding 5) of that total period.
- **4. Revocation**—The Civil List (Annuities) Determination 1989\* is hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This determination, which is deemed to have come into force on 1 April 1990, increases the rate of the annuity payable to a former Governor-General (who was domiciled in New Zealand at the time of appointment) and the rate of the annuity payable to the widow or widower of such a Governor-General.

The rates applying before the date of the commencement of this determination were fixed, as at 1 April 1989, by the Civil List (Annuities) Determination 1989.

In the case of a former Governor-General who held office for a total period of less than 2

complete years, the yearly rate of the annuity is now increased from \$6,780 to \$7,280. In the case of a former Governor-General who held office for a total period of 2 complete years or more, the sum of \$6,780 payable for each complete year (not exceeding 5) of that total period is now increased to \$7,280.

In the case of the widow or widower of a person who held office as Governor General, the increases now effected in the rates of annuities are such that the annuity payable in each case continues to be one-half of the annuity that would have been payable to the person who held office as Governor-General.
