

## THE CIVIL LIST DETERMINATION 1994

---

PURSUANT to section 3 (1) (a) and (2) of the Civil List Act 1979 (as substituted by section 3 (1) of the Civil List Amendment Act 1985) and to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, the Higher Salaries Commission hereby makes the following determination.

---

### DETERMINATION

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This determination may be cited as the Civil List Determination 1994.

(2) This determination shall be deemed to have come into force on the 9th day of November 1993.

**2. Expiry**—This determination shall expire on the 8th day of November 1994.

**3. Salary of Governor-General**—(1) The salary payable to the Governor-General pursuant to section 3 (1) (a) of the Civil List Act 1979 shall be paid at the rate of \$99,500 a year.

(2) The salary specified in subclause (1) of this clause is determined on the basis that it is and will remain exempt from income tax.

**4. Revocation**—The Civil List Determination 1993\* is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This determination, which is deemed to have come into force on 9 November 1993, increases from \$97,500 to \$99,500 a year the rate at which the salary of the Governor-General is payable.

The salary of the Governor-General is determined on the basis that it is and will remain exempt from income tax.

This determination expires on 8 November 1994.
