

THE CIVIL LIST DETERMINATION (NO. 2) 1995

PURSUANT to section 3 (1)(a) and (2) of the Civil List Act 1979 (as substituted by section 3 (1) of the Civil List Amendment Act 1985) and to the Higher Salaries Commission Act 1977, the Higher Salaries Commission hereby makes the following determination.

DETERMINATION

1. Title and commencement—(1) This determination may be cited as the Civil List Determination (No. 2) 1995.

(2) This determination shall be deemed to have come into force on the 12th day of December 1995.

2. Expiry—This determination shall expire on the 31st day of December 1996.

3. Salary of Governor-General—(1) The salary payable to the Governor-General pursuant to section 3 (1)(a) of the Civil List Act 1979 shall be paid at the rate of \$106,000 a year.

(2) The salary specified in subclause (1) of this clause is determined on the basis that it is and will remain exempt from income tax.

4. Revocation—The Civil List Determination 1995* is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the determination, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This determination, which is deemed to have come into force on 12 December 1995, increases from \$102,000 to \$106,000 a year the rate at which the salary of the Governor-General is payable.

The salary of the Governor-General is determined on the basis that it is and will remain exempt from income tax.

This determination expires on 31 December 1996.
