THE CONTACT LENSES NOTICE 1963, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to regulation 4 of the Social Security (Hospital Benefits for Outpatients) Regulations 1947*, the Minister of Health hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. This notice may be cited as the Contact Lenses Notice 1963, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Contact Lenses Notice 1963† (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

2. Clause 4 of the principal notice is hereby amended by revoking subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (a), and substituting the following subparagraph:

“(ii) The lenses are supplied and fitted in accordance with an agreement made between the suppliers and the Minister of Health; and”.

3. The proviso to clause 5 of the principal notice is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (b), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(b) The lenses are supplied and fitted in accordance with an agreement made between the suppliers and the Minister of Health.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice provides for the supply and fitting of any type of contact lenses without the need to approve the particular type or the need to enter into an agreement with each manufacturer.
