### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 8th day of July 1974

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 (1) of the Civil List Act 1950 (as substituted by section 2 (1) of the Civil List Amendment Act 1972), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Civil List Order 1974.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 1972.

**2. Allowance of Governor-General**—The allowance payable to the Governor-General for expenses, pursuant to section 3 (1) (b) of the Civil List Act 1950, shall be at the following rate:

(a) On and after the 1st day of October 1972, at the rate of \$14,910 a year:

(b) On and after the 1st day of October 1973, at the rate of \$16,231 a year.
