



## THE CIVIL LIST ORDER 1975, AMENDMENT NO. 1

PURSUANT to section 3 (1) of the Civil List Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Civil List Order 1975, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Civil List Order 1975\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 1974.

**2. Amendment of date of commencement of principal order**—Clause 1 (2) of the principal order is hereby amended by omitting the expression “10th”, and substituting the expression “1st”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Civil List Order 1975 (which fixes the allowance of the Governor-General) is retrospective to 10 October 1974. It should be retrospective to 1 October 1974. This order corrects the error.
