ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of November 1978

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 (1) of the Civil List Act 1950 (as substituted by section 2 (1) of the Civil List Amendment Act 1972), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Civil List Order 1978.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 1978.

2. Allowance of Governor-General—The allowance payable to the Governor-General for expenses pursuant to section 3 (1) (b) of the Civil List Act 1950 shall be at the rate of \$40,344 a year.

3. Revocation—The Civil List Order (No. 2) 1977* is hereby consequentially revoked.
