**THE CIVIL LIST ORDER 1984**

ORDER IN COUNCILAt the Government Buildings at Wellington this 26th day
of March 1984

PURSUANT to section 3 (1) (b) of the Civil List Act 1979, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Civil List Order 1984.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 1982.

2. Allowance of Governor-General—The allowance for expenses that is payable to the Governor-General, pursuant to section 3 (1) (b) of the Civil List Act 1979, shall be—

- (a) In respect of the year beginning on the 1st day of October 1982 and ending with the close of the 30th day of September 1983, at the rate of \$90,087 for that year; and
- (b) On and after the 1st day of October 1983, at the rate of \$94,943 a year.

3. Revocation—The Civil List Order (No. 2) 1981* is hereby consequentially revoked.P. G. MILLEN,

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases the rate at which the Governor-General's allowance for expenses is payable. As from 1 October 1982, the rate is increased from \$77,255 a year to \$90,087 a year. As from 1 October 1983, the rate is increased to \$94,943 a year.
