# ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 26th day of March 1984

#### Present:

THE RIGHT HON. SIR ROBERT MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 3 (1) (b) of the Civil List Act 1979, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Civil List Order 1984.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 1982.
- 2. Allowance of Governor-General—The allowance for expenses that is payable to the Governor-General, pursuant to section 3 (1) (b) of the Civil List Act 1979, shall be-
  - (a) In respect of the year beginning on the 1st day of October 1982 and ending with the close of the 30th day of September 1983, at the rate of \$90,087 for that year; and (b) On and after the 1st day of October 1983, at the rate of \$94,943 a
  - year.
- 3. Revocation—The Civil List Order (No. 2) 1981\* is hereby consequentially revoked.

# EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases the rate at which the Governor-General's allowance for expenses is payable. As from 1 October 1982, the rate is increased from \$77,255 a year to \$90,087 a year. As from 1 October 1983, the rate is increased to \$94,943 a year.
