**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 24th day of November 1986

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 (1)(b) of the Civil List Act 1979 (as substituted by section 3 (1) of the Civil List Amendment Act 1985), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Civil List Order 1986.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 1986.

**2. Allowance of Governor-General**—The allowance for expenses that is payable to the Governor-General, pursuant to section 3 (1)(b) of the Civil List Act 1979, shall be paid at the rate of \$84,499 a year.

**3. Revocation**—The Civil List Order 1985\* is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which is deemed to have come into force on 1 October 1986, increases from \$72,500 a year to \$84,499 a year the rate at which the Governor-General's allowance for expenses is payable.
