ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 25th day of November 1996

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 (1) (b) of the Civil List Act 1979 (as substituted by section 3 (1) of the Civil List Amendment Act 1985), His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Civil List Order 1996.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October 1996.
- 2. Allowance of Governor-General—The allowance for expenses that is payable to the Governor-General, pursuant to section 3 (1) (b) of the Civil List Act 1979, shall be paid at the rate of \$126,302 a year.
- **3. Revocation**—The Civil List Order 1995* is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The order, which is deemed to have come into force on 1 October 1996, increases from \$123,342 a year to \$126,802 a year the rate at which the Governor-General's allowance for expenses is payable.
