THE CENTRAL MILK COUNCIL (FEES AND TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCES) REGULATIONS 1950

Pursuant to the Milk Act, 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Central Milk Council (Fees and Travelling-allowances) Regulations 1950.
- 2. The Central Milk Council (Fees and Travelling-allowances) Regulations 1945* are hereby revoked.
- 3. (1) The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949† shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to the Central Milk Council established under the Milk Act, 1944, and its members and to any Committee thereof, and the members of any such Committee.
- (2) The subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 5 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be at the rate of £1 15s. a day:

Provided that where a member is entitled to a subsistence allowance and occupies a hotel room for one night only, an additional amount of 2s. may be paid to that member.

(3) The mileage allowance referred to in Regulation 13 of the Travelling-allowance Regulations 1949 shall be calculated in accordance with the following table:—

(4) Garage expenses payable to a member pursuant to this regulation shall not exceed 2s. 6d. for every night on which any such expenses are incurred.

- 4. The remuneration by way of fees or allowances referred to in section 99 of the said Act shall be—
 - (a) For each day or part of a day on which a member is in attendance at a meeting of the Council or of any Committee thereof, a sum of £3 3s.:
 - (b) For any time in which a member is otherwise actually engaged in transacting any business of the Council or of any Committee thereof, a payment at the rate of £3 3s. for a day of twenty-four hours.
