## THE CHEQUES ORDER 1960

COBHAM, Governor-General  
ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 8th day of December 1960

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section 5 of the Cheques Act 1960, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Cheques Order 1960.

2. For the purposes of paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section 5 of the Cheques Act 1960, the said section 5 shall apply to any document, not being a bill of exchange, issued by any person or authority which is intended to enable a person to obtain payment of the sum mentioned in the document from any account specified in the Schedule to this order.

### SCHEDULE

#### ACCOUNTS TO WHICH SECTION 5 OF CHEQUES ACT 1960 IS APPLICABLE

1. Any account which is for the time being subject to Part IX of the Public Revenues Act 1953 by virtue of section 72 of that Act.

2. Bank accounts of any Education Board for the time being constituted under the Education Act 1914.

3. The following bank accounts while kept in New Zealand:

- (a) The Western Samoa Treasury Imprest Account:

- (c) The Niue Island Administration Account:
- (d) The New Zealand Patriotic Fund Imprest Account:
- (e) The Canteen Fund Imprest Account:
