**THE CHIROPRACTORS ORDER 1993**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At Wellington this 13th day of September 1993

THE RIGHT HON. D. C. MCKINNON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 14 (2) of the Chiropractors Act 1982, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

---

**ORDER**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Chiropractors Order 1993.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 15th day of October 1993.

**2. Recognised qualifications**—(1) The First Schedule to the Chiropractors Act 1982 is hereby amended by adding to the list of qualifications and institutions set out in that Schedule the following paragraphs:

“(c) A Bachelor of Applied Science (Chiropractic) degree granted by the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology, Melbourne, Australia; or

“(d) A Master of Chiropractic degree granted by the Macquarie University, Sydney, Australia; or

“(e) A double degree Bachelor of Clinical Science, Bachelor of Chiropractic Science granted by the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology, Melbourne, Australia.”

(2) The First Schedule to the Chiropractors Act 1982 is hereby further amended by adding to the final item in paragraph (b) of the list of qualifications and institutions set out in that Schedule the expression “; or”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 15 October 1993, amends the First Schedule to the Chiropractors Act 1982. That Schedule lists recognised qualifications. This order adds, to the qualifications listed in that Schedule, the following qualifications:

- (a) A Bachelor of Applied Science (Chiropractic) degree granted by the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology, Melbourne, Australia; and
- (b) A Master of Chiropractic degree granted by the Macquarie University, Sydney, Australia; and
- (c) A double degree Bachelor of Clinical Science, Bachelor of Chiropractic Science granted by the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology, Melbourne, Australia.

The first of the new qualifications results from the incorporation of the Phillip Institute of Technology, Melbourne, Australia into the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology.

The second and third of the new qualifications are qualifications recognised for the first time.
