PURSUANT to the Judicature Act, 1908, and section 3 of the Judicature Amendment Act, 1930, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council and with the concurrence of the Right Honourable the Chief Justice and six of the other members of the Rules Committee constituted under the Judicature Amendment Act, 1930 (three of such other members being Judges of the Supreme Court), doth hereby make the following rules.

RULES

1. These rules may be cited as the Court of Appeal Amendment Rules 1946.
2. Rules 15A and 15B of the Rules of the Court of Appeal as inserted by the Court of Appeal Amendment Rules 1940* are revoked.
3. Nevertheless, matter printed or typewritten, as the case may be, in manner complying with the rules hereby revoked shall be accepted for filing in the Court at any time until the 28th day of February, 1946, and may, with the leave of the Court, be accepted at a later date if prepared before the date of this enactment.
