ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 16th day of June 1952

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Judicature Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and with the concurrence of the Right Honourable the Chief Justice and six other members of the Rules Committee constituted under the Judicature Amendment Act 1930 (three of such other members being Judges of the Supreme Court), hereby makes the following rules.

RULES

1. (1) These rules may be cited as the Court of Appeal (Fees) Rules 1952, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the rules of the Court of Appeal set out in the Third Schedule to the Judicature Act 1908.

(2) These rules shall come into force on the fourteenth day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. (1) The fees specified in the Schedule hereto shall be payable, in proceedings in the Court of Appeal, in respect of the matters so specified.

(2) The fees to be charged in respect of matters not specified in the said Schedule shall be the fees charged in respect of similar matters in ordinary civil proceedings in the Supreme Court.

3. The scale of fees fixed on the 29th day of July 1920* is hereby consequentially revoked.
