THE CERTIFICATE OF FITNESS EXEMPTION ORDER 1956

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 4th day of April 1956

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 118 (1) (c) of the Transport Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Certificate of Fitness Exemption Order 1956.

2. Goods service vehicles for the time being used in connection with any goods service carried on within the Great Barrier Island are hereby exempted from the requirements of section 118 (2) of the Transport Act 1949 as to certificates of fitness and permits.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.]

This order exempts goods service vehicles on Great Barrier Island from the certificate of fitness requirements of the Transport Act 1949.
