HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Cinematograph Films Act, 1928, as amended by section 18 of the Statutes Amendment Act, 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Cinematograph Operators Licensing Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Cinematograph Operators Licensing Regulations 1938* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. Clause 18 of the principal regulations is amended by adding thereto the following additional paragraph:—
 - "(c) When successive provisional licenses are issued to the same person for periods which taken together fall entirely within the same triennial period, no fee shall be payable for any such provisional license after the first."
