THE CINEMATOGRAPH OPERATORS LICENSING REGULATIONS 1938, AMENDMENT NO. 4

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of December 1955

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Cinematograph Films Act 1928 and section 18 of the Statutes Amendment Act 1936, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Cinematograph Operators Licensing Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Cinematograph Operators Licensing Regulations 1938* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) A representative of the Department of Internal Affairs, who shall be Chairman:”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

The effect of these regulations is that a representative of the Department of Internal Affairs is to be appointed a member of the Cinematograph Film Operators Licensing Board in place of the Chief Inspector of Explosives.
