## A PROCLAMATION.

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the Sale of Wool Act, 1937, I, George Vere Arundell, Viscount Galway, Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand do hereby proclaim and declare that the Sale of Wool Act, 1937, shall come into force on the 1st day of July, 1938.
