THE COINAGE PROCLAMATION, 1947

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section eight of the Coinage Act, 1933, and for the purposes of determining the dimensions, the designs, and the denominations, weights, and composition of cupro-nickel coins to be made and issued under the said Act, and the amount of the remedy to be allowed in the making thereof, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as follows :—

1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Coinage Proclamation, 1947.

2. There may be made and issued cupro-nickel coins of the denominations specified in the Schedule hereto.

3. The designs and dimensions of the said cupro-nickel coins shall be the same as those set out in Part I of the Coinage Proclamation, 1939, in respect of silver coins.

4. The composition and weights and the amount of the remedy to be allowed in the making of the said cupro-nickel coins shall be as specified in the Schedule hereto.
