**THE CUSTOMS PRIMAGE (ELECTRICAL CONDENSERS)
EXEMPTION ORDER 1956**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 22nd day of August 1956

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Primage (Electrical Condensers) Exemption Order 1956.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 24th day of August 1956.

2. (1) The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the primage duty imposed by section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931.

(2) The Order in Council* dated the 28th day of August 1936 exempting certain goods from primage duty is hereby amended by omitting from the Schedule the words "(2) Switchboards, fuse boards, and distribution boards or boxes for electric circuits; shunt or voltage regulators; starters or controllers for electric motors; rheostats, and resistances n.e.i. including reactance or choking coils, for the reduction or control of electric currents, condensers, relays, electro-magnets, switches, wall-plugs and shoes or sockets therefor, circuit breakers, circuit makers, cut-outs, fuses, wire or cable connectors and *similar* articles, and terminals; lightning arresters for the protection of electrical apparatus."
