Pursuant to section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Primage (Electrical Condensers) Exemption Order 1957.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 24th day of August 1956.
- 2. (1) The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the primage duty imposed by section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931.
- (2) The Customs Primage (Electrical Condensers) Exemption Order 1956* is hereby amended by omitting from the Schedule so much thereof as relates to Tariff item 338 (2) (c).
