**THE CUSTOMS PRIMAGE (ELECTRICAL CONDENSERS)
EXEMPTION ORDER 1957**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Primage (Electrical Condensers) Exemption Order 1957.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 24th day of August 1956.

2. (1) The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the primage duty imposed by section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931.

(2) The Customs Primage (Electrical Condensers) Exemption Order 1956* is hereby amended by omitting from the Schedule so much thereof as relates to Tariff item 338 (2) (c).
