THE CUSTOMS PRIMAGE EXEMPTION ORDER 1946

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1931, and all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Customs Primage Exemption Order 1946.
2. This Order shall come into force on the 16th day of August, 1946.
3. The classes of goods set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the primage duty imposed by section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1931.
4. The class of goods set out in the Schedule hereto and therein identified by a Tariff item number shall be deemed to be the same class of goods as the class of goods set out in the First Schedule to the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1934, to the description of which is prefixed the same Tariff item number.
