**THE CUSTOMS PRIMAGE EXEMPTION ORDER 1951**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 17th day of  
April, 1951

Present :

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows :—

1. (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Primage Exemption Order 1951.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 20th day of April, 1951.

2. The classes of goods included in the Tariff items set out in the Schedule hereto are hereby exempted from the primage duty imposed by section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act, 1931.
