**THE CUSTOMS PRIMAGE (FOOTWEAR)  
EXEMPTION ORDER 1957**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 5th day of June 1957

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

**1.** (1) This order may be cited as the Customs Primage (Footwear) Exemption Order 1957.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 7th day of June 1957.

**2.** The class of goods set out in the Schedule hereto is hereby exempted from the primage duty imposed by section 4 of the Customs Acts Amendment Act 1931.

**3.** The Customs Primage Exemption Order (No. 5) 1955\* is hereby amended by omitting from the First Schedule so much thereof as relates to Tariff item 196 (1).
